

## 2002 SXV700G, SXV700ERG Hood \& Belly Pan Misalignment \& Hood Cracking



Problem: When riding in rough trail conditions, the hood can become dislodged and misaligned with the belly pan.

Cause:
Belly pan flexing.
Remedy: Modify the hood and belly pan to prevent misalignment and hood cracking.

NOTE: If the hood locating channels are cracked, do not replace the hood. Performing the modification should remove the cracked area of the hood channel. In the future, if installing a new hood on a machine, be sure to perform this modification to the hood prior to installation.
Parts
Required: None.
Warranty: Submit a Service-Per-Bulletin (90 Code) Warranty Request for labor reimbursement.


## AFFECTED RANGE

All SXV700G/ERG models.

SERVICE PROCEDURES
Using hand tools (e.g., utility knife or box cutter) perform the following procedure.
NOTE: Final material removal should be done with a file or sandpaper.

1. Hood Modification: Remove a section of the forward inside edges of both right-hand (RH) and lefthand (LH) locating channels as shown in the illustration below:

2. Belly Pan Modification: Remove a section of both right-hand (RH) and left-hand (LH) sides of the belly pan as shown in the illustration below. Take care not to remove excess material to avoid a gap between the hood and belly pan.

STARTING AT THIS POINT, MAKE A MARK AT THE
FOLLOWING 3 LOCATIONS (SEE "X" MARKS):
40mm FORWARD 85mm REARWARD
